**NEW EPA VICTORIA WORKS  
APPROVALS GUIDELINES**

EPA Victoria has published new Guidelines for Works Approvals. Works approvals are public documents issued by EPA Victoria under the Environment Protection Act 1970 (the Act) and are required for industrial and waste management activities that have the potential for significant environmental impact. The approvals permit the construction of a plant, the installation of equipment or modification of processes. The new guidelines have been updated to make applying for works clearer and easier. They work in parallel with the new application form, which is designed to streamline assessment of proposals. Members from the Statutory Facilitation Unit of EPA Victoria who worked on the development and release of the new guidelines will present details and answer queries.

Tony Robinson is the Manager of Statutory Facilitation Unit and responsible for managing EPA's Works Approvals and licensing system as well as advising the Authority on planning issues. Tony was actively involved in developing the new guidelines. Tony is a long term member of CASANZ.

John Marsiglio is involved with the assessment of applications for works approvals and licences and provides expert energy and greenhouse advice. John is also a long term member of CASANZ. John with Andrew worked on the internal and external release and communication of the new works approval guidelines.

Andrew Oliver is involved with the assessment of applications for works approvals, licences and biosolids approvals.
